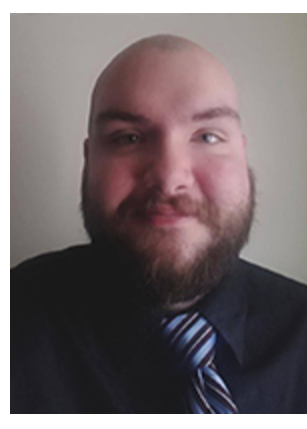
Alumni Spotlight

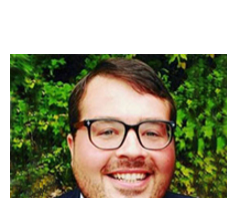
