U Giving Day Is Here!

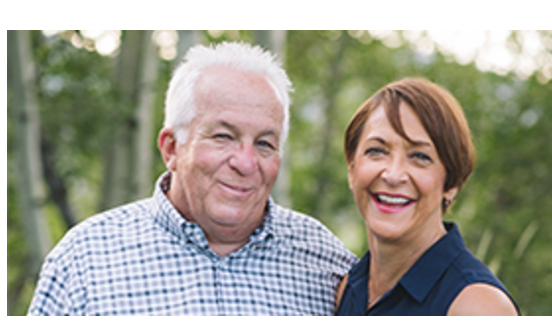
